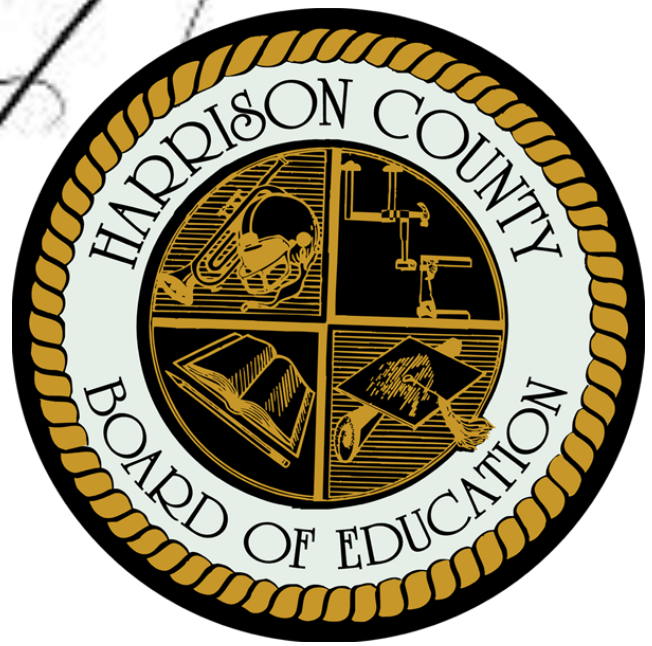

Meet the Conductors



Dr. Robert Palmer - High School Guest Conductor

West Virginia Wesleyan College

Robert Palmer joined West Virginia Wesleyan College as the Director of Athletic and Concert Bands in July of 2022. Prior to his appointment to WVWC, he spent a year as the head of the wind division of The Music Center/A Plus Guitars in Bridgeport, WV and subbed in Harrison County. He was previously the Director of Athletic Bands at Alderson Broaddus University in Philippi from 2015-2017.

As a conductor, Palmer has directed groups all around the country and in nearly every medium of performance including choirs, orchestras, concert and athletic bands, and some jazz groups.

Palmer is also a well-traveled hornist, having performed on three continents including a 10-day tour of Brazil and world premieres for horn and wagner tuba in Belgium. He has presented on performance anxiety and educator burnout at the state, regional, and international levels.

Palmer received his Bachelor and Master degrees from Western Illinois University where he was a student of Randall Faust on horn and Mike Fansler, Douglas Phillips, Shawn Vondran, and Matt Thomas in conducting/wind-band. His doctorate is in Brass Performance with a specialty in horn from Florida State University under the tutelage of Michelle Stebleton. His professional memberships include the National Association for Music Educators, the National Band Association, the International Horn Society, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. His works are published through Wavefront Music.

Mr. Josh Chiado - Middle School Guest Conductor

Taylor County Middle School

A native of Clarksburg, Josh Chiado developed a love for music at an early age. From the age of five, he would watch rehearsals of local high school bands and begin to mimic the percussion parts. This childhood experience helped to shape his musical journey and guide him through a successful music career.

After graduating from Robert C. Byrd High School in 1999, he decided to attend Alderson-Broaddus College and earned a Bachelor of Music Arts degree. He was involved in the Concert Band, Brass Choir, Jazz Band, Choir, Handbell Choir and the “The West Virginians” during his time at A-B. A few years later, Chiado attended Fairmont State University and earned his certification in Music Education.



Chiado served as the Adjunct Professor of Percussion at A-B from 2008-2013 where he was responsible for Percussion Ensemble, Jazz Band, Percussion Pedagogy, Battler Band Drumline and Private Lessons. He also served as the Adjunct Professor of Percussion at Fairmont State from 2016-2021 where he was responsible for Percussion Ensemble, Private Lessons, and served as the Assistant Director of Athletic Bands. He also served as the percussion arranger for the Mon Valley Express Drum and Bugle Corps (2013).

An active composer, numerous schools have used his percussion arrangements for marching band, percussion ensemble, and percussion solos.

In December 2023, Chiado was named the state of West Virginia representative for “50 Band Directors Who Make a Difference” that was featured in School Band & Orchestra Magazine. Josh is currently serving as the Director of Bands at Taylor County Middle School in Grafton, WV where his primary responsibilities include teaching concert band and marching band.
